



Expectations for children attending clubs



1. Children can attend more than one club in a half term as long as they are not run at the same time.
2. If a child has applied for a club and there is a charge, the letter will state how much the club will cost which can be paid every week or paid in full before the club begins.
3. By signing the consent letter you are agreeing that the amount will be paid. The child will not be able to attend another club until the amount has been paid.
4. If a child misses a session of the club they need a valid reason for not attending. It would be courteous for the child to apologise to the club leader either before the club or as soon as possible after and explain the reason for not attending.
5. If a child joins a club but doesn't attend and they do this on two separate occasions they will be selected last when wanting to join another club with a waiting list. We encourage all children to show commitment to a club for the length of time it is run in that half term, e.g. six weeks.
6. It is expected that children behave during school clubs. Children need to be aware that there are three strikes for unacceptable behaviour and then they will be asked to leave the club and not attend the following week.
