

Cyber attack guidelines to staying safe

A cyber attack is a type of virus that infects computers, and then prevent the user from accessing the operating system, or encrypts all the data stored on the computer. It could be that a ransom is then asked for usually a fixed amount of money. It is essential to ensure you have a backup of your own files to a USB drive or stick, the computer operating systems can be restored and your files will remain safe.

If your computer gets infected take it off of your internet / network immediately! The ransomware will spread to other computers on the network!

- Be wary of visiting unsafe or unreliable sites.
- Never click on a link that you do not trust on a that you do not trust on a web page, facebook or other messaging applications such as WhatsApp.
- If you receive a message from your friend with a link, ask them before opening the link to confirm, (infected machines send random messages with links).
- Keep your files backed up regularly and periodically.
- Be aware of fraudulent e-mail messages that use names similar to popular services such as PayePal instead of PayPal or use popular service names without commas or excessive characters.



- use an anti-virus and always be up to date.
