<u>PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING THAT YOU CAN</u>. Every year we have sack loads of clothes left behind. Children seem to find it very difficult recognising their own towels, tracksuit bottoms and t-shirts if they are not wearing them! THIS IS ESSENTIAL!!

PLEASE NOTE: Brand new and expensive clothes should be left at home. Please do not go out and buy new clothes, it will become very dirty and could get ruined. Strong old clothes are much more appropriate. An outfit for the disco is allowed, but remember it may be left in a bag for 4 days. The staff at the centre, and those from school, are not responsible for anything lost or broken. Any lost property will be collected and can be claimed from school the week after our visit; after this it will be disposed of (due to smell!!)
