DINING AT HILLSTONE

GETTING READY FOR NURSERY

Supporting your child to do these things before they start in September will make a real difference to the experience they have when they start school.

- Make sure they can use the toilet independently.
- Encourage them to put on and take off their own coat.
- × Prepare them to hang up their coats by themselves.
- × Help them to use a knife and fork to eat
- 🗶 Read to your child every day
- × Help them to read their name
- Talk to them about how much fun they will have in Nursery!







SUPPORTING YOUR CHILD

Once your child is settled in school, you can support them in these few simple ways in ord er for them to be happy, secure and successful.

- × Punctuality and attendance
- Reading together at home. Your child will bring home a library book and a picture book each week.
- Talking to your child about what they are learning.
- Counting to 10 each day and counting objects at home.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club offers cereals, toast or fruit, and milk or water. Our Breakfast Club starts at 8:00am and doors will close at 8:30. The cost of Breakfast Club is 40p per child per day.

We also offer an Early Birds breakfast club. This starts at 7:30am and doors will close for this at 8:00am. The cost of the Early Birds Breakfast Club is £3.50 per child per day.



AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

The After School Club can be booked through Scopay, our online payment system. Advanced booking is essential. Please contact the office in an emergency for on the day booking and we will aim to accommodate you. The cost of the club is £9 per child per session from 3:10pm to 6:00pm. During the club children will be able to take part in a range of activities and they will also have a 2 course hot meal before they leave.

We are delighted to welcome you to your Hillstone Primary School online account. Your account will allow you to check balances for dinner money, trips and clubs and to make payments to the school. You can also use your account for other tasks such as booking sessions for Breakfast Club and After School Club, checking your child's meal history, ordering uniform and printing receipts.

You can use the same account for any children you have at this school, and for children at other schools that also use Tucasi secure scopay.com system.

Please set up your Scopay account in readiness for September.

I already have a scopay.com account for another child:

Log on to your account using your existing username and password. Select the Link — Accounts option from the Your Info menu heading and enter the unique online link code to add an account. Your unique online Tucasi link code has been sent to you in the post and looks similar to this '1234567:9abe59794g' - You will need to enter the whole code.

I don't yet have a scopay.com account:

Visit <u>www.scopay.com/hillstonepri</u> and Register as a New User. Follow the instructions on the screen to enter your details and add the unique online Tucasi link code for your child when prompted. **Your unique online Tucasi link code has been sent to you in the post** and looks similar to this '1234567:9abe59794g' - You will need to entre the whole code.

Note: The online link code is for one time use only. It is not needed once the account has been activated.

If you have received more than one account access letter, for siblings at this school, create your account as above for the first child and link the second child using the instructions in the 'I already have a scopay.com account' option above.
