<u>Autumn 1</u> Presenting Myself  <b>Intermediate Language Teaching</b>	Lesson 1: I have recapped previous Spanish learning. Lesson 2: I can say my name, ask someone their name and recite the numbers 11 – 20 in Spanish. Lesson 3: I can speak and understand the numbers 10 – 20 and ask and answer the question, “How old are you?” in Spanish. Lesson 4: I can ask and answer the question, “Where do you live?” in Spanish. Lesson 5: I can say what nationality I am from in Spanish. <b>End of unit assessment</b> – chn to write a conversation in Spanish.
<u>Autumn 2</u> Family  Intermediate Language Teaching	Lesson 1 and 2: I have learnt the basic nouns and definitive articles for family members. Lesson 3: I can ask and answer questions about family members. Lesson 4: I have learnt the Spanish numbers to 100. Lesson 5: I can introduce members of my family in Spanish. Lesson 6: I can describe and have a brief conversation about my family. <b>End of unit assessment:</b> video chn having a conversation that includes the Spanish they already know from previous unit and the new family language learnt from this unit.
<u>Spring 1</u> In the classroom  Intermediate Language Teaching	Lesson 1: I have learnt the vocabulary for 6 classroom objects. Lesson 2: I have learnt the vocabulary for the next 5 classroom objects. Lesson 3: I can understand and use basic classroom commands. Lesson 4: I can use ‘tengo’ and ‘no tengo’ accurately. Lesson 5: I can say what I do and do not have in my pencil case. <b>End of unit assessment:</b> video chn using the classroom language they have learnt this unit.
<u>Spring 2</u> What is the date?  Intermediate Language Teaching	Lesson 1 and 2: I can name the twelve months of the year. Lesson 3: I can say the date in Spanish. Lesson 4: I can say my birthday in Spanish. <b>End of unit assessment:</b> chn to write a summary paragraph of who they are, when their birthday is and their family members are in Spanish.
<u>Summer 1</u> At the cafe  Intermediate Language Teaching	Lesson 1: I have learnt the vocabulary for a range of drinks. Lesson 2: I have learnt the vocabulary for a range of food. Lesson 3 and 4: I can order something to eat and drink in a Spanish café. Lesson 5: I can say what I eat for breakfast. <b>End of unit assessment:</b> video chn using their new vocabulary in a conversation.
<u>Summer 2</u> Do you have a pet?  Intermediate Language Teaching	Lesson 1: I have learnt the vocabulary for eight common pets. Lesson 2: I can use the phrase ‘tengo’ and ‘y’ in relation to the pets I have. Lesson 3: I can use the phrase ‘que se llama’. Lesson 4: I can use the phrases I have already learnt and the phrase ‘no tengo’ when talking about pets. Lesson 5: I have revised and recapped all the new language I have learnt about pets. <b>End of unit assessment:</b> chn to write a summary paragraph that includes all the Spanish they have learnt in Y3 and Y4.
