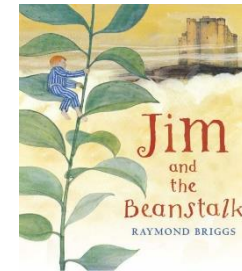


Year 1 **Happily Ever After**

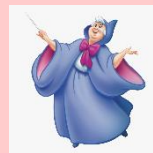
